


Dutchess County Sampler Initiative

Announcing the *Dutchess County Sampler Initiative* a county wide effort to locate, photograph, and document American samplers and related girlhood embroideries held in the public and private collections of Dutchess County, New York. Coordinators for this initiative are working with local museums, historical societies, historic homes, private collectors, and descendants, to identify antique schoolgirl samplers in their collections and document them for inclusion in the Sampler Archive, an online searchable database of American schoolgirl needlework (samplerarchive.org).
